to begin on December 1, 2022. The position is limited until December 31, 2022. The salary is based on the German public pay scale (TV-L 14) if the conditions of the collective agreement are met. The regular weekly working hours are 100% of a full-time employee (currently 38,7).

Profile: Dendroarchaeology

The Post Holder will conduct research on human-environmental-interdependencies in the area of dendro-archaeology, dendro-ecology, and dendro-climatology. Aspects of woodland management, climate reconstruction, adjustment of wood growth with other ecological proxies and dating enhancement shall be in the focus of research. Studies in isotope research in collaboration with the Leibniz-Laboratory are envisaged. She/he will build up a dendro-ecological lab and to initiate own research based on internal and external funding.

Integration into the research agenda of ‘ROOTS of socio-environmental hazards’ is expected as well as cooperation with the other subclusters. The position offers opportunities for joint research especially with the Doctoral and Postdoctoral Researchers.

Required qualifications:

- Excellent PhD and proven strong research track demonstrating pertinent experience in at least two of the fields of dendro-archaeology, dendro-ecology, and dendro-climatology.
